

Bath Sword Club are pleased to invite you to the inaugural U15 Junior Excalibur competition at King Edwards School, Bath, BA2 6HU on Sunday 10th March 2019.

It is to be run as a six weapon inter county competition, initially without the requirement for counties to enter a full complement of six weapon teams. Teams are to be made up of three or four fencers. Fencers are only permitted to fence in one weapon team. Counties may enter up to two teams per weapon if they cannot make the full compliment of MF, WF, ME, WE, MS, WS. Fencers must be under 15 and over 11 years of age on 1 January 2019.

Equipment requirements: 800N plastrons, breeches & long socks for all fencers. Chest protectors for female fencers. Size 5 or below blades. Conductive bibs & mask wires for foil.

It is the intention to run the event over one day only, as a 45 hit relay format. The precise format, i.e. promoted poules, as per Much Wenlock, or direct elimination from a seeded tableau with all places fenced for, will be decided nearer the time. All bouts will be presided by junior fencers and counties will be required to provide a referee mentor for each weapon to support their refs on the piste. Prizes will be awarded for the best teams in each weapon along with an overall county winner.
